



**2010-11** Perhaps conditions today are not ideal to ski with your multi-day ticket. Maybe you just need a day off. The good news is there are many fun opportunities for you on the mountain. You have the choice today (the valid day of the ticket) to exchange your day of skiing for any one of the following options. If you have decided that you do not want to ski today, just bring your ticket to the Activity Center to exchange it. Remember, you must exchange your ticket on the day it is valid to take advantage of this opportunity.

**Come back and visit later.**

We can issue you a lift ticket that will be good for any day during the 2010-11 season. Snow checks are transferrable and can be given to a friend.

**Slide the slippery slopes at the Hermits Hollow Tubing Center.**

We will make a prepaid reservation for you and a friend for a 1.5 hour tubing session. We'll even include a coffee drink and snack afterwards at the Mojo Coyote or Cabinet Mountain Coffee so you can warm up afterwards.

**Try Nordic Skiing.**

Schweitzer has over 32km of groomed Nordic trails. We'll set you up with a complete rental package and a trail pass to go out and explore the winter wonderland.

**Take a lesson.**

Every great athlete has a coach. We have one for you! Our Snowsports School offers lessons daily. We can exchange your ticket for today for a **group** lesson later during your stay. Cannot be applied toward packages.

**Relax with a treatment from Solstice Spa.**

Take a deep breath and let Solstice Spa take you to a whole new level of relaxation. You can exchange your ticket for a 25 minute quick fix massage, a foot massage, or \$40 off any other treatment offered.

**Learn to Snowshoe.**

We'll provide the snowshoes and a trail pass for you to go out and explore the trails! Warm up with a coffee drink and snack afterwards at the Mojo Coyote or Cabinet Mountain Coffee. If you prefer to snowshoe with someone else, join in on any of the hosted hikes at no additional charge.

**Demo some equipment another day**

Thinking about new gear? The best way to know what you want is to try it out first. Demo a pair of top quality skis or a snowboard from the Source located in the Ski and Ride Center. (Boots and poles are not included)

**Visit with local artists at the Artist Studio**

We'll give you a \$40 voucher to shop at the Artist Studio where you can visit with artists or watch demonstrations. Some of the top local artists display their work at the coop.

### **Paint Some Pottery**

You choose your project(s) up to \$40 in value, paint them with glazes and Lisa from Pottery in Motion will fire the project and ship it right to your door. (Available on weekends, or additional days in Sandpoint. Check for schedule availability)

We will provide transportation and a host for all off site events. Events must be scheduled in advance and are subject to availability.*

## **Art gallery tour**

Sandpoint is home to almost two dozen galleries! We'll visit a minimum of four art galleries and finish the day with appetizers and a glass of wine at Enoteca La Stanza in Sandpoint.

## **Shopping and lunch**

There's no better way to work up an appetite than sorting through Sandpoint's many shops. Have lunch at Jalapenos or MickDuff's Brewing company. Then our host will give you all you need to navigate yourself to the best shops downtown.

## **Wine tasting and snacks**

Explore Sandpoint's own Pend Oreille Winery. Meet the winemakers and learn what it takes to produce gold medal quality wines. Day includes a wine flight, cheese plate and plenty of time to shop.

## Multi-day ticket options: How it works.

The ticket will be valid for one day longer than purchased - that is, a three day purchase will be good for 3 out of 4 days, a four day ticket will be good for 4 out of 5 days etc.

If you purchase a ticket good for 3 or more days of lift access and decide that you do not want to ski all of those days you can exchange one or more days of your multi-day ticket for several other opportunities ranging from dining to demos.

The requirements are simple. Think of a 4 day lift ticket as having 4 credits on it that can be used over a 5 day period.

1. Once you have skied on any lift, a credit is removed.
2. The credits are only good while the ticket is valid.
3. Once you have exchanged or skied on a credit, it cannot be exchanged again.
4. The valid dates of a ticket cannot be changed once the ticket is purchased.
5. Credits do not have cash value and cannot be redeemed for cash.
6. All exchanges must be made at the Activity Center.

### Examples

#### Here is an example that works.

John has a 4 out of 5 day ticket. He skis on day one and day two. Now he is tired and takes a rest day on day three. When he wakes up on day four, he realizes that he does not want to ski that day and exchanges his day for a snowshoe hike and picnic lunch. On day five he feels refreshed and goes out to ski again.

#### Here is an example that does not work.

Our friend John has a 4 out of 5 day ticket. He skis on day one and day two. Now he is tired and takes a rest day on day three. When he wakes up on day four, he realizes that he does not want to ski that day and takes another rest day with no exchange. On day five he feels refreshed and goes out to ski again. The next morning, on day six, he requests a gift certificate for the unused day. He is told that the ticket is no longer valid and cannot be exchanged.
