## **Summer Activities**

From late June until Labor Day weekend, Schweitzer's other season is in full swing. The summer is full of mountain biking, hiking, and scenic chairlift rides from 11am - 5pm daily. Sky House is also open daily offering lunch on the summit while taking in the views. Stop by the Summer Activity Center and learn about local flora and fauna as well as how to identify wildlife on the mountain. Schweitzer also has its own hike-to lake where you can catch and release rainbow trout. August is a great time to find huckleberries!



#### **Scenic Chairlift Rides**

Hop on the Great Escape Quad and take a scenic ride to the top of Schweitzer Mountain. Along the way, you can take in the cool breeze and sweeping views. At the summit you can enjoy lunch at Sky House, free disc golf course, or hike on the summit trails.

All lift tickets are valid for 1 day of unlimited rides. Bringing a bike? Purchase a Mountain Bike Lift Ticket for even more thrilling fun all day.



#### **Mountain Biking**

Whether you're a downhill junky, cross country fanatic or just looking for a fun outing on the mountain Schweitzer a has over 40 miles of trail for you to explore.

Downhill-only trails require a lift pass but our XC trails are free to access. for more information on all the trails in the area be sure to pick up a summer trail map or visit schweitzer.com.



#### **Hiking & Huckleberries**

Schweitzer offers over 20 miles of trails to explore. Walk through old growth forest with wildflowers or through mountainside meadows with views for miles. During late July & early August huckleberries are in full abundance. Stop by the Summer Activity Center for a free trail map and the latest info on huckleberry hot spots.





There are elements of risk in skiing/riding that commonsense and personal awareness can reduce

- 1. Always stay in control, and always be able to stop and avoid other people or objects.
- 2. People ahead of you have the right of way. It is your responsibility to avoid them.
- 3. You must not stop where you obstruct a trail, or are not visible from above.
- 4. Whenever starting downhill or merging into a trail, look uphill and yield to others.
- 5. Always use devices to help prevent runaway equipment.
- 6. Observe all posted signs and warnings. Keep off all closed trails and out of closed areas.
- 7. Prior to using any lift, you must have the knowledge and ability to load, ride and unload safely.
- 8. Know the code-it's your responsibility. This is a partial list. Visit schweitzer.com for more information.



#### **Tree Well And Deep Snow Safety**

Skiing and snowboarding off the groomed runs and in deep powder is one of the most exciting and appealing parts of our sport. However, if you decide to leave the groomed trails you are voluntarily accepting the risk of a potential avalanche and/or a deep snow immersion accident. A deep snow, or tree well immersion accident occurs when a skier or rider falls into an area of deep unconsolidated snow and becomes immobilized and suffocates. Stay safe, always use the buddy system and keep an eye on each other. Visit schweitzer.com for more safety & avalanche info.

#### Schweitzer Area Boundary Policy

Schweitzer Mountain has no obligation to anyone proceeding beyond the area boundary. If you choose to cross the area boundary, you do so at your own risk and assume the burden of responsibility for your actions. Avalanche danger and other hazards exist. You are solely responsible for your safety and welfare and all the costs of rescue. All boundaries are shown on the mountain maps and are marked with signs or ropes, DO NOT CROSS ROPED AREAS AT ANY LOCATION ON THE MOUNTAIN AT ANY TIME. Access to out-ofbounds areas is through designated gates only. These gates are identified on the map with the following symbol: To not cross the area boundary without a partner and the necessary equipment to negotiate the backcountry safely.



Schweitzer and the surrounding area comprises of over 40 miles of trail to explore including 4 hiking specific trails and 10 designated downhill only mountain bike trails. Downhill mountain bike trails are intermediate to advanced skill level and require a lift ticket for access. The multi-use trails are open to hikers & bikers and are free to access. Horseback rides are offered on-site through Mountain Horse Adventures but privately owned horses and all motorized traffic is prohibited on these trails. ## Hike: Nature Trail to the Summit Distance: 2.5 miles one way

Difficulty: Strenuous

Reward yourself with amazing views and a cold drink at Sky House. Hike back down or enjoy a complimentary chairlift ride down.

#### Hike or Bike: Picnic Point

Distance: 3 miles round trip Difficulty: Moderate

A great place to pack a lunch & enjoy the views of Lake Pend Oreille and the city of Sandpoint.

## HIKE, BIKE, FISH: Colburn Lake Distance: 4 miles round trip

Difficulty: Moderate

Stop by the Summer Activity Center for your free fishing license and info before heading out to Colburn Lake. Take the Service Road to access this small lake on the Outback Bowl side of Schweitzer. Please note there is no access from the summit and the trail around the lake is foot traffic only.


#### BIKE: Highpoint Trail to Little Sand Creek Watershed Trail Network

Distance: 9 miles one way - mostly singletrack Difficulty: Moderate

Take the Great Escape chairlift to the summit then enjoy over 10 miles of mostly single track back down to the valley floor. Selkirk Rec. District runs a shuttle on the weekends to get you back to the Schweitzer village. For full route info visit schweitzer.com.

#### **HUCKLEBERRY PICKING:** Typically late July through early August
