## HYDRANT PERMIT PROGRAM

Permits are only issued for the designated hydrant filling station located to the left of the entrance to the Gateway Parking Lot (blue dot in photo):



No other hydrants are authorized for use as filling stations or a water source, and use of any hydrant other than the designated hydrant constitutes a violation.

**Failure to comply with this permit will result in banning the user from further use.**

The purpose of a Hydrant Permit is to protect the public by reducing the chance of contaminants entering the public water system and to accurately capture water consumption/usage.

Users are required to submit an application and pay a non-refundable fee of \$10.00 **per day** before their first use.

Once your application and fee have been received, you will be notified of permit approval & authorization to draw water from the hydrant from May 1st. through October 1st. **PLEASE NOTE:** The actual availability of water is weather dependent and freezing temperatures will dictate if/when the hydrant can be used.

Users will need to provide their own **FIRE HYDRANT WRENCH!**  
**USING ANYTHING OTHER THAN A FIRE HYDRANT WRENCH TO OPERATE THE HYDRANT IS A VIOLATION AND WILL RESULT IN THE USER BEING BANNED FROM FURTHER WATER USE!**

The fill hose coming off the hydrant backflow assembly has a 2 1/2" female, Camlock Quick Connect fitting to connect to fill pipes. Users will need to provide their own fittings to connect this hose to the fill pipe of their truck/tank (if needed).

Prior to your first fill you must have your vehicle or tank inspected by S.M.U./M.U.C. and confirm that you understand how to properly OPEN and CLOSE a hydrant to prevent "water hammer" and possible damage to the Distribution system or setting off the building fire alarm/suppression systems.

***Any user who causes damage to the Distribution system or sets off fire alarms due to water hammer will be held liable for the cost of repairs, or to reset the alarm system!***
