Are there any learning differences that we should know about so that we can best accommodate your child: For example, ADHD, physical limitations, anxiety in groups, communication issues:

- Level 1:** “Never skied or snowboarded” to “learning how to make turns and stop safely”.
- Level 3:** Starts on Musical chairs
Skier: Can stop and turn both ways in a wedge.
Snowboarder: Can turn on heel-side edge, learning toe-side edge.
- Level 5:** **Skier:** Turning parallel only occasionally in a wedge on Ridge Run and other blue slopes.
Snowboarder: Able to link toe and heel-side turns on easier terrain.
- Level 7:** **Skier:** Always turning parallel, rarely in a wedge, except on more difficult terrain (Ridge Run, Great Divide, and Zip Down).
Snowboarder: Able to link toe and heel edge turns on most terrain. Can ride switch on easier terrain.
- Level 9:** **Skier:** Always turning parallel on all terrain at a safe pace (Pend Orielle, JR, Hollywood). Can vary turn shape and dynamics to adjust for different terrain and snow conditions (powder, bumps, trees, steeps)
Snowboarder – Able to link toe and heel edge turns on all terrain. Can ride switch on more difficult terrain. Can vary turn shape to adjust for different terrain and snow conditions (powder, bumps, trees, steeps).
- Level 9+:** **Skier:** Always dynamic parallel on all terrain at a safe pace (KMAX, Pucci’s Chute). Can vary turn shape and dynamics to adjust for different terrain and snow conditions (excellent in powder, bumps, trees, steeps, chutes, terrain park features).
Snowboarder – Links dynamic turns on all terrain. Can ride switch, olly on demand and vary turn shape and dynamics to adjust for different terrain and snow conditions (excellent in powder, bumps, trees, steeps, chutes, terrain park features).

I agree to RELEASE, HOLD HARMLESS, AND INDEMNIFY SCHWEITZER MOUNTAIN SKI OPERATIONS LLC, ("SCHWEITZER"), ITS OWNERS, AFFILIATES, AGENTS AND EMPLOYEES from all claims for any cause, including negligence, which arises out of participation in skiing, snowboarding and all related activities; including, but not limited to, Schweitzer Snowsports School programs and travel to and from Schweitzer Mountain, or travel to and from Schweitzer Snowsports School.

I agree that if any portion of this agreement is held to be invalid, the remaining terms shall continue to be in full force and effect. This agreement shall be binding upon any other persons, including my heirs, assigns, and representatives.

If I am signing on behalf of a minor, I accept full responsibility for all medical expenses incurred as a result of the minor's participation in skiing, snowboarding and all related activities, including Schweitzer Snowsports School programs and/or travel to and from Schweitzer Mountain. I understand my child may ride the lift alone, with another child or with an adult other than his coach. I also agree to HOLD HARMLESS AND INDEMNIFY Schweitzer Snowsports School and Schweitzer for any claims brought by or on behalf of the minor.

In case of an emergency if I cannot be reached, Schweitzer has my permission to obtain any medical and/or First Aid treatment necessary for my child, and I agree to be financially responsible for any medical services deemed necessary.
